FAQs

- 1. Is it a zero-demolition project or can one consider minimal civil work? Can roofs of anganwadis be rebuilt?
- A. All *anganwadis* can undergo structural refurbishments which can include sunshades/ roofs. Participants are welcome to suggest alternatives for the same.
- 2. The brief states competition entries should include detailed design of two *anganwadi* sites and general design guidelines for the remaining ones. However, some sites accommodate two *anganwadis* within its premises. How should one treat such sites?
- A. Sites that accommodate two *anganwadis*, say for example, *anganwadis* 5 and 6, shall be considered as one site and not two. Hence, participants must submit detailed designs for 2 different locations/sites irrespective of the no. of *anganwadis* within one premise/site.
- 3. Is participation form a part of '3 nos. A3 sheets' or should it be attached as a separate document?
- A. The design proposals must be mailed to nnckochi@gmail.com in the below mentioned sequence, complied as a single PDF. The submission PDF must include:
 - I. filled participation form
 - II. A3 design sheets (not more than 3) including
 - a. design concept,
 - b. key plan and detailed drawings,
 - c. visualizations and illustrations supporting design,
 - III. write-up of 200- 300 words explaining design idea
- 4. Has a budget been assigned for 'refurbishment/ remodelling' for each *anganwadi*?

 A. Yes, a fixed budget has been allotted for refurbishment of *anganwadis*. The proposed elements must be good quality yet low-cost design solutions for play and recreation of young children and their caregivers.
- 5. How many caregivers are assigned to each *anganwadi*? What are the working hours of *anganwadi*?
- A. Every anganwadi has two teachers, and functions 6 days a week from 9am to 3pm.
- 6. Can wall tiles and exterior paving tiles be removed as part of 'remodelling/refurbishment'? A. Yes, wall and external paving tiles can be removed as part of the proposal.
- 7. Can a common access be provided between two classrooms of *anganwadis* which are located within same premise?
- A. *Anganwadis* sharing common premises cannot have interlinked access, however common play areas and waiting spaces for caregivers can be proposed.
